**KAEDAH-KAEDAH UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA (PERKARA AKADEMIK
PRASISWAZAH) (PINDAAN) 2026**

Suatu Kaedah-Kaedah bagi meminda Kaedah-Kaedah Universiti Putra Malaysia (Perkara Akademik Prasiswazah) 2014.

Pada menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh seksyen 37(1) Perlembagaan Universiti Putra Malaysia, Lembaga Pengarah Universiti membuat seperti berikut:

Tajuk Ringkas, Pemakaian dan Permulaan Kuat kuasa

1. Kaedah-Kaedah ini bolehlah dinamakan Kaedah-Kaedah Universiti Putra Malaysia (Perkara Akademik Prasiswazah) (Pindaan) 2026 dan hendaklah mula berkuat kuasa pada 18 Oktober 2021.

Tafsiran

2. Dalam Kaedah-Kaedah ini, melainkan konteksnya menghendaki makna yang lain—

“Kaedah-Kaedah Ibu” ertinya Kaedah-Kaedah Universiti Putra Malaysia (Perkara Akademik Prasiswazah) 2014.

Pindaan Kepada Kaedah 52 Kaedah-Kaedah Ibu

3. Kaedah 52 Kaedah-Kaedah Ibu dipinda seperti berikut:

(a) Memasukkan selepas Kaedah 52 Kaedah-Kaedah Ibu Kaedah 52A seperti berikut:

“Penilaian Pelajar Doktor Veterinar

52A. (1) Selain daripada penilaian di bawah Kaedah 52, Pelajar yang mendaftar kursus pengajian doktoral veterinar hendaklah dinilai oleh Universiti melalui peperiksaan seperti yang ditetapkan dalam Jadual Keempat A.

(2) Senat boleh dari semasa ke semasa meminda Jadual Keempat A”.

Pindaan Kepada Jadual Kaedah-Kaedah Ibu

4. Memasukkan selepas Jadual Keempat Kaedah-Kaedah Ibu Jadual Keempat A seperti berikut:

“JADUAL KEEMPAT A
(Kaedah 52A)

(Peperiksaan Komprehensif Doktor Perubatan Veterinar)

Pelajar Doktor Perubatan Veterinar mesti menduduki Peperiksaan Komprehensif sebagai salah satu bentuk penilaian semasa pengajiannya. Peperiksaan Komprehensif Doktor Veterinar mempunyai 2 tahap.

1. Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif merupakan peperiksaan tahap 1 diambil oleh pelajar Doktor Perubatan Veterinar tahun tiga pengajian manakala Peperiksaan Komprehensif tahap 2 diambil oleh pelajar Doktor Perubatan Veterinar tahun akhir pengajian.
2. Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif dijalankan pada minggu pertama cuti semester kedua tahun tiga pengajian.
3. Bagi membolehkan pelajar mengambil Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif, pelajar hendaklah memenuhi syarat berikut:
 - (i) Lulus semua kursus teras fakulti yang diambil pada empat semester pertama iaitu pada tahun pertama dan tahun kedua pengajian.
 - (ii) Pelajar yang tidak mengambil atau gagal mana-mana kursus teras fakulti yang diambil sepanjang empat semester pertama tidak dibenarkan menduduki Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif.
 - (iii) Pelajar yang gagal Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif kali pertama dibenarkan menduduki semula peperiksaan tersebut pada semester yang sama.
 - (iv) Pelajar yang gagal Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif di bawah perenggan (iii) di atas perlu mendaftar dan mengulang Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif pada semester tujuh pengajian.
 - (v) Pelajar yang gagal Peperiksaan Pra-Komprehensif ulangan tidak boleh menyambung pengajian dalam program yang sama.
4. Peperiksaan Komprehensif dijalankan pada minggu pertama cuti semester akhir pengajian.
5. Bagi membolehkan pelajar mengambil Peperiksaan Komprehensif, pelajar hendaklah memenuhi syarat berikut:
 - (i) Lulus semua kursus teras fakulti sepanjang tempoh pengajian mulai semester pertama hingga semester akhir pengajiannya;

- (ii) Pelajar yang gagal Peperiksaan Komprehensif dibenarkan menduduki semula Peperiksaan Komprehensif pada semester yang sama;
- (iii) Pelajar yang gagal Peperiksaan Komprehensif di bawah perenggan 5(iii) perlu mendaftar dan mengulang Peperiksaan Komprehensif pada semester berikutnya; dan
- (iv) Bagi mengelakkan keraguan, proses pengulangan Peperiksaan Komprehensif hendaklah tidak melebihi tempoh lapan (8) tahun pengajian, dan tempoh lapan (8) tahun pengajian adalah tidak termasuk tempoh penangguhan pengajian pelajar itu.”

CONSTITUTION OF UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA

UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA (ACADEMIC MATTERS FOR
UNDERGRADUATES (AMENDMENT) RULES 2026

A Rules to amend Universiti Putra Malaysia (Academic Matters for Undergraduates) Rules 2014.

IN EXERCISE of the power conferred by section 37(1) of the Constitution of Universiti Putra Malaysia, the Board of Directors makes the following Rules:

Short Title, Application and Date of Commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as Universiti Putra Malaysia (Academic Matters for Undergraduates) (Amendment) 2026 and shall come into force on 18 October 2021.

Interpretation

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Parent Rules” means Universiti Putra Malaysia (Academic Matters for Undergraduates) Rules 2014.

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Interpretation

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Parent Rules” means Universiti Putra Malaysia (Academic Matters for Undergraduates) Rules 2014.

Amendment to Rule 52 of the Parent Rules

3. Rule 52 of the Parent Rules is amended as follows:

(a) by inserting after Rule 52 the Parent Rules, Rule 52A as follows:

“Evaluation of Veterinary Doctor Students

52A. (1) Apart from the assessment under Rule 52, Students who are registering for the doctoral of veterinary course of study must be assessed by the University through examination as stipulated in the Fourth Schedule A.

(2) Senate may from time to time amend the Fourth Schedule A”.

Amendments to the Schedule of Parent Rules

4. By inserting after the Fourth Schedule the Parent Rules, the Fourth Schedule A as follows:

**“Fourth Schedule A
(Rule 52A)**

(Doctor of Veterinary Medicine Comprehensive Examination)

Student of Doctor Veterinary must sit for Comprehensive Examination as one of his forms of assessment during his studies. The Comprehensive Examination of Doctor Veterinary has 2 levels.

1. The Pre-Comprehensive Examination is a level 1 examination sat by the students of Doctor of Veterinary Medicine in the third year of study while the Comprehensive Examination level 2 is sat by the students of Doctor of Veterinary Medicine in the final year of study.
2. The Pre-Comprehensive Examination is conducted during the first week of the second semester of the third year of study.
3. To enable students to sit for the Pre-Comprehensive Exam, students must comply the following conditions:
 - (i) has passed all the faculty’s core courses in the first four semesters, which is the first and second year of study.
 - (ii) Students who do not sit, or fail any of the faculty’s core courses during the first four semesters is not allowed to sit for the Pre-Comprehensive Examination.

- (iii) Students who fail the Pre-Comprehensive Exam for the first time are allowed to re-sit the same exam in the same semester.
 - (iv) Students who fail the first Pre-Comprehensive Examination under paragraph (iii) above must register and repeat the Pre-Comprehensive Examination in the seventh semester of his study.
 - (v) Students who fail the repeat of the Pre-Comprehensive Examination shall not be allowed to continue studies in the same programme.
4. The Comprehensive Examination is conducted during the first week of the final semester break.
5. To enable students to sit for the Comprehensive Examination, students must comply the following conditions:
- (i) has passed all core courses of the faculty throughout the period of study from the first semester to the final semester of his studies;
 - (ii) Students who fail the Comprehensive Examination for the first time is allowed to re-sit the said Comprehensive Examination in the same semester;
 - (iii) Students who fail the Comprehensive Examination under paragraph 5(iii) have to register and repeat the Comprehensive Examination in the following semester; and
 - (iv) For the avoidance of doubt, the process of repeating the Comprehensive Examination shall not exceed a period of eight (8) years of study, and the period of eight (8) years of study shall not include the period of deferment of his studies.”
